Jazz Pianist



Rob Allgeyer is among a small group of musicians who believes in playing music people of all ages and musical backgrounds can appreciate.

In 1993 Rob entered the U.C. - College Conservatory of Music and for the next four years he was one of their most in demand pianists. While studying under Phil DeGreg, Rob was part of the Jazz Ensemble as well as the featured pianist in many student recitals and on several CD's produced by the College Conservatory of Music. While he was at CCM, Rob landed a steady gig on Monday and Tuesday nights at the Dee Felice Café in Covington. While there, he developed a style and repertoire that kept people coming back again and again.

Since then he has played regular engagements at The Blue Wisp Jazz Club, Simone's and The Netherland Hilton in Cincinnati, Pacchia's Jazz Room in Dayton, The Jazz Factory in Louisville, and Chez Nora in Covington. He also led The Rob Allgeyer Trio four nights a week for seven years at The Iron Horse Inn in Glendale. In addition to performing at clubs and concert venues around the tristate area, The Rob Allgeyer Trio and Quartet have recently performed live concerts on WVXU 91.7 FM in Cincinnati and on WFPK 91.9 FM in Louisville.

As a teacher, Rob has enjoyed his work with the College Conservatory of Music Prep Department, The School of Creative and Performing Arts and the Glendale Music Academy. He is currently focusing on his own teaching studio in Glendale, Ohio.

Currently, Rob is the pianist with The Ron Jones Quartet based in Louisville, leads his own Trio and is a member of the Brazilian Jazz group Trio Pi.
